

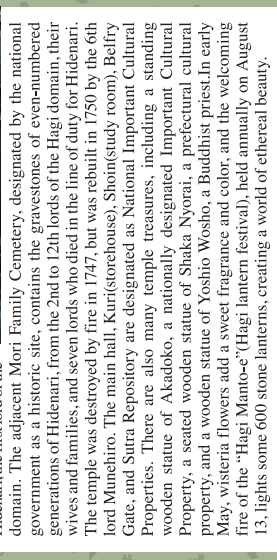

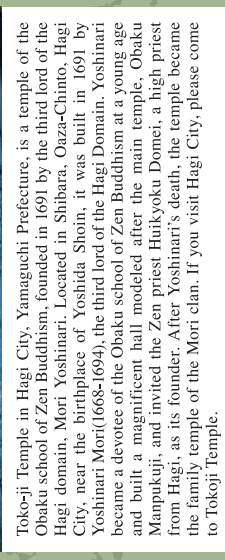
The historical street the route map of the Hagi Historical Parade Lord street

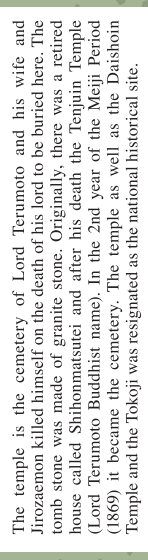

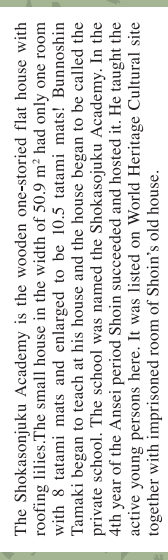

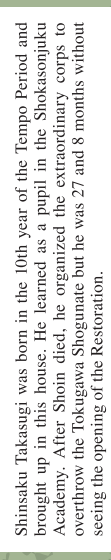

In 1604 (in the 9th year of the Keicho) after Hagi Castle was built, the Hagi Historical Parade Lord Street was opened as Mori Lords' Parade Street. It connected Hagi Castle Town (Hagi City) and Mitaziri (Hofu City) harbor in the Inland Sea of Japan as a straight line of the full length about 53 km. Originally, it was maintained as the street of lord's alternate-year residence in Edo but became the connecting between the Sanin and Sanyo Area. In the last days of the Tokugawa Shogunate, not only Shoin Yoshida but also noble-minded patriots came and went and played a very important part. The Hagi Historical Parade Lord Street was appointed and chosen as a historic spot, one of the historical streets, a street on which people want to walk, a Dream street of the Renaissance, Japan's landscape street. We'd like you to walk the Hagi Historical Parade Lord Street.

1 Ruins of Hagi Castle

The Castle which Lord Terumoto Mori built after his defeat of the Sekigahara battle is famous for the cherry tree. Especially, midoriyoshino cherry tree should be observed. (the prefectural natural treasure)

2 The Hagi Museum

This is the best museum for leaning Hagi's nature, history, and culture.

4 The old Meirinkan of the Hagi Domain School

The Primary School building built in the 10th year of the Showa Period is the national tangible property. It is now used as the Hagi Meirin building.

3 The Kikuya side street

The white-mad wall covered with white tiles-raised with white plaster is beautiful and chosen as one of "the 100 Japan's streets".

5 The site of the Karahi bulletin Board

The starting point of the Hagi historical Parade Lord street, the Akamagaseki street and the Sekishu street. The bulletin Board on which notices from the Shogunate and the domain. It is also the starting point of the 4 km point from Suo and Nagato.

7 Hagi Station building
The site of the Okibara Foundry

The white and attractive station building built in the 14th year of the Taisho (1925) was revived and is the national tangible property.

8 The site of the Namida Pine Tree

The persons who are leaving Hagi shed tears to see the last scene of Hagi Castle town and also shed tears when they return to Hagi. That's why the tree is called "a pine tree in tears."

9 The Ume Garden Park by the Hagi Historical Parade Lord street

The park was opened as a memory of the 160th anniversary of the birth of Shoin Yoshida.

12 The Kase Tunnel

The national tangible property made of stone about 182 m in length, 4.2 m in width and 3.9 m in height.

13 Kasegasaka kagotateba

The rest facility for a party of the lord including two stands for the Lord Palanquin made of cut grasses.

14 The Seiraiji Temple

There is the same crest of chrysanthemum as the imperial family on the wall of the main gate.

15 The Zuikoji Temple

The Zuikoji in Akiragi. The mold of the splendid gate is beautiful.

18 Kingaeki

It is said that a long time ago, when a great thief was executed, he buried a thousand ryokan he had stolen in the middle of Ishodani, and although many people have searched for it since then, it has never been found....

19 The Gomonzō stone-paved pavement

The top point (10 gome) of the Issho stone-paved road is before our eyes.

20 4 km mound of Nakanotogeshita

21 The summit of Shichikendo

The fishing fire can be seen off the coast of Hagi.

22 The Ochiai stone bridge

The drawbridge 2.4 m in length, 1.7 m in wide unique in Yamaguchi Prefecture. The national tangible property.

25 The Kifune Shrine

Praying up the stone steps near Sasanami Ichigashira Ichirizuka. Since no one was killed in the Sino-Japanese and Russo-Japanese wars from this area, many people who went to war visited the shrine.

27 The suicide kannon

The employee whose samurai was killed because of the go game trouble visited the grave and heard him talk in the reedy bushes and found the head in the marsh. He held a memorial service. That's why he could revenge.

Sasanami central area

The area of the district of historical reservation of historical important houses was chosen as the inn station of the Hagi Historical Parade Lord street. The old kobayashi house is maintained as the tea house of the walkers on the Historical Parade street.

24 Sasanamiichigashira 4 km mound

16 km from Hagi. 32 km to the Mitajiri port.

28 Kaminagase 4 km mound

The Kaminagase 4km mound is left as it used to be, and it is 20 km from Hagi and 28km Hofu Mitaziri.

26 The Fuchigahira Falls

The Amagoi abyss to pray for rain in dry climate.

30 The monument of the Boarder

The granite Monument boarder between Nagato and Suo, Yamaguchi city from here!
